Provide two examples of transnational companies that were formed to control export economies.

Discuss at least one environmental impact that resulted from industrialization.

Name at least two factors that contributed to Chinese migration during the period 1750-1900.

Name at least one factor that contributed to Indian migration to South Africa during the period 1750-1900.

Discuss two factors that contributed to the Irish Potato Famine.

Discuss the political impacts of the Irish Potato Famine between the years 1850 and 1914.

What were similarities and differences in indentured service during the 16th century as compared to the 19th century?

What common factor accounts for the use of indentured servants in both the 16th and 19th Centuries?

What factor accounts for the difference between indentured service in the 16th and 19th Centuries?

Evaluate the extent to which the use of indentured servants changed in the period 1750-1900.

What historical context helps explain the change in indentured servitude?

Discuss how the Industrial Revolution contributed to social changes such as changes to the “traditional family”, increasing demand for women’s rights, and male suffrage rights in the period 1750-1900.

Why did the Industrial Revolution result in urban overcrowding?

How did industrialization impact women, children, and the “traditional” family?

Evaluate the extent to which the treatment of women changed in the period 1750-1900.

What 17th Century historical context helps explain why the treatment of women changed?
